

What happens if I'm subtracting a negative?

$$3 - (-3)$$

This is called a **double negative**

$$3 + + 3 = 6$$

$$\textcircled{4} \quad 2 - 3 = -1$$

$$\textcircled{5} \quad 5 + + 4 = 9$$

$$\textcircled{6} \quad -5 + + 4 = -1$$

$$\textcircled{7} \quad -5 - 4 = -9$$

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
